FROGS *of* BRUNEI

There are over 85 species of frogs and toads from seven families recorded from Brunei Darussalam. About two-thirds of them are endemic to Borneo. Adults of some species can be as small as 18 mm and as large as 180 mm. Eggs can be laid in streams, pond, tree holes, as well as above ground in foam nests or attached to leaves.
